

ASSOCIATE IN ARTS FOR BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy both the requirements for an Associate in Arts at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky and pre-major requirements for a bachelor of science degree in Career and Technical Education.

In addition to the following course recommendations, students must be admitted to the teacher education program (TEP) after they have completed (or complete during the semester in which you apply) 60 semester hours of course work—including AED/FCS 110: Introduction to Career and Technical Education—and have at least a 2.75 grade-point standing. Applicants are evaluated on an interview, recommendations, scholastic achievement, demonstrated skills, and professional commitment and goals.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with the UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure both KCTCS and UK requirements are met.
