Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy both the requirements for an Associate in Arts at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky and pre-major requirements for a bachelor's degree in Journalism.

The College of Communications is a selective admission college and requires a 2.0 cumulative GPA. If the student elects to pursue a Bachelor's of Science in Journalism or chooses Option B under the Bachelor of Arts, the foreign language courses will differ.
