

**ASSOCIATE IN ARTS FOR BACHELOR'S OF ARTS IN PUBLIC POLICY**

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy both the requirements for an Associate in Arts at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky and pre-major requirements for the bachelor's of arts degree in Public Policy in the Martin School of Public Policy and Administration.

The Martin School of Public Policy and Administration a selective admissions college and requires an overall GPA of 2.75 as well as a 2.75 minimum pre-major GPA. Pre-major GPA includes the equivalent of CIS/WRD 110, CIS/WRD 111, MA 113 or MA 123, PS 101, PPL 201, ECO 201, and ECO 202.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with the UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure both KCTCS and UK requirements are met.
