# Parking and Transportation Options for the 2022-23 Academic Year

Is your student planning on bringing a car to campus? They'll need to purchase a parking permit. For complete information, visit <a href="https://www.uky.edu/transportation/park/studentpermits">uky.edu/transportation/park/studentpermits</a>.

We've highlighted a few permit types and important dates below.

#### First-Year Students Living in On-Campus Housing

Resident (R) Permits - These allow students to park at spots closest to the residence halls; spaces are limited.

Sales begin at noon EST on Tuesday, June 14

Periphery (K) Permits - Affectionately known as K Lot, these permits allow students to park at Kroger Field and is the most affordable option. K Lot permits do not sell out.

Sales begin at noon EST on Friday, July 1.

First-Year Students Living Off-Campus/Commuting to Campus Commuter (C) Permits - These permits allow students to park at locations reasonably close to desired campus locations. Spaces are limited.

Sales begin at noon EST on Friday, July 1.

Periphery (K) Permits - Affectionately known as K Lot, these permits allow students to park at Kroger Field and is the most affordable option. K Lot permits do not sell out. Several campus bus routes pick up and drop off at K Lot, making it easier to get to classes.

### SAVE THE DATE - BIG BLUE MOVE-IN

Big Blue Move-In, when UK students move into the residence halls for the fall semester, is right around the corner! Your student will receive detailed communication over the next few months with everything they need to know about move-in.

Most first-year students will move into their residence halls between Monday, August 15, and Wednesday, August 17.

Students will also receive instructions about signing up for a move-in appointment. Move-In appointments are designated 30-minute windows of time for you to arrive at the unloading area of your hall during Big Blue Move-In.

These appointments minimize traffic delays, maintain efficiency and help everyone have a good experience throughout the move-in process. Students are required to sign up for a move-in appointment.
