Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Science at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to a BS in Agricultural Education at the University of Kentucky.

Admission Requirements

Students must meet the University admission requirements to be admitted into any major within the College of Agriculture Food and Environment (CAFE).

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

Degree Requirements

The College of Agriculture, Food, and Environment requires that students maintain a 2.75 GPA to obtain a teaching license.

General Transfer Requirements
