



TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2022-2023

Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Art Education

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Arts at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to the Bachelor of Arts degree in Art Education at the University of Kentucky.

Admission Requirements

Art Education is a selective admission and competitive program. Completing this pathway does NOT guarantee you acceptance into the program. Acceptance is determined through the application process. A 2.75 cumulative GPA will be needed for this program. Students should talk to their future assigned UK College of Fine Arts advisor after their second semester so that they're aware of Teacher Education Program (TEP) application requirements, which is the teacher certification program built into the UK degree. To stay on a four-year path, students must be eligible to apply to the TEP the semester before they plan to attend UK.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

Degree Requirements

Students can transfer a total of 67 credit hours from a two-year institution. Additionally, 30 of the final 36 credit hours earned toward a UK degree must be completed at UK. To graduate, students must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA and complete 120 total credit hours.

General Transfer Requirements

All prospective transfer students are encouraged to receive advising from the University of Kentucky Transfer Center. Appointments are offered online and in-person, and can be scheduled online at <https://www.uky.edu/admission/transfer-advising>.
