### **Overview**

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Arts at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky and pre-major requirements for a bachelor of health sciences degree in Communication Sciences and Disorders.

### **Admission Requirements**

The College of Health Sciences is a selective college at UK with additional requirements, including a 3.0 cumulative GPA, three letters of recommendation, and a secondary application in addition to the main UK application for admission.
