



TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2022-2023

Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Science in Consumer Economics and Family
Financial Counseling

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Arts at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to the Bachelor of Science degree in Consumer Economics and Family Financial Counseling at the University of Kentucky.

Admission Requirements

The College of Agriculture, Food and Environment at the University of Kentucky is a non-selective admissions college, requiring a 2.0 cumulative GPA for admission purposes. However, for the Consumer Economics and Family Financial Counseling major, students must earn a C or better in ECO 201 to proceed with the upper-division courses.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

Degree Requirements

Students can transfer a total of 67 credit hours from a two-year institution. Additionally, 30 of the final 36 credit hours earned toward a UK degree must be completed at UK. To graduate, students must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA and complete 120 total credit hours.

The College of Agriculture, Food, and Environment, Consumer Economics and Family Financial Counseling (CEF) major requires that KCTCS students have taken BAS 120 as well as ECO 201, ECO 202, and ACC 201. The CEF major will require students to take two internships following your May commencement participation with an August graduation date.

General Transfer Requirements
