



## TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2022-2023

Associate in Art to Bachelor's in Family Science

### Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Science at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to a Bachelor's in Family Science at the University of Kentucky.

### Admission Requirements

Students must meet the University admission requirements to be admitted into any major within the College of Agriculture Food and Environment (CAFE).

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

### Degree Requirements

The College of Agriculture, Food, and Environment requires that students take BAS120, FAM 252, FAM 253, as well as COM 252 prior to transferring to UK.

The Family Sciences major requires professional support, or a minor. Examples include Psychology, Sociology, Community, Leadership & Development, Kinesiology & Health Promotion, Communication, Criminology, etc.). Your UK advisor will assist you in choosing one. The Family Sciences degree also requires you to complete an internship and 45 hours of upper-level credit.

### General Transfer Requirements

All prospective transfer students are encouraged to receive advising from the University of Kentucky Transfer Center. Appointments are offered online and in-person, and can be scheduled online at <https://www.uky.edu/admission/transfer-advising>.
