



TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2023-2024

Associate in Science to Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Science at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and lead to the Bachelor in Science degree in Criminal Justice at the University of Kentucky.

Admission Requirements

The Criminal Justice major is highly flexible. Students are encouraged to pursue minors and certificates of interest. Please speak to an advisor regarding your areas of interest.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

Degree Requirements

Students can transfer a total of 67 credit hours from a two-year institution. Additionally, 30 of the final 36 credit hours earned toward a UK degree must be completed at UK. To graduate with the Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice, students must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA and complete 120 total credit hours.

General Transfer Requirements

All prospective transfer students are encouraged to receive advising from the University of Kentucky Transfer Center. Appointments are offered online and in-person, and can be scheduled online at https://www.uky.edu/admission/transfer-advising.
