Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Health Sciences in Communication Sciences and Disorders

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Arts at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky and pre-major requirements for a Bachelor of Health sSiences degree in Communication Sciences and Disorders.

Admission Requirements

The College of Health Sciences is a selective college at UK with additional requirements, including a 3.0 cumulative GPA, three letters of recommendation, and a secondary application in addition to the main UK application for admission.
