Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Science in Health
Promotion (Teacher Certification)

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Arts at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky and pre-major requirements for a Bachelor of Science degree in Health Promotion- Non-Teacher Certification.

Admission Requirements

Health Promotion is a selective admission and competitive program. Completing this pathway does NOT guarantee you acceptance into the program. Acceptance is determined through the application process. A 2.75 cumulative GPA will be needed for this program.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.
