Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Science in Agricultural  
Education and Advocacy

### Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Science at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to a BS in Agricultural Education & Advocacy at the University of Kentucky.

### Admission Requirements

Students must meet the University admission requirements to be admitted into any major within the Martin-Gatton College of Agriculture Food and Environment (M-G CAFE).

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

### Degree Requirements

Students must be admitted to the Teacher Education program (TEP) after completing or during the semester in which the student applies, 60 credit hours of coursework, AEA 110 and have at least a 2.75 GPA (on a 4.0 scale)

The College also requires a grade of C or higher in ECO 201.

### General Transfer Requirements

All prospective transfer students are encouraged to receive advising from the University of Kentucky Transfer Center. Appointments are offered online and in-person, and can be scheduled online at <https://www.uky.edu/admission/transfer-advising>.
