## TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2025-2026

Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Science in  
Hospitality Management and Tourism

### Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Arts at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to a Bachelor of Science in Hospitality Management and Tourism at the University of Kentucky.

### Admission Requirements

Students must meet the University admission requirements to be admitted into any major within the Martin-Gatton College of Agriculture, Food and Environment (M-G CAFE).

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

### Degree Requirements

The Hospitality Management and Tourism degree requires that students complete a 320-hour, 8-week internship in a selected agency or organization, under the joint supervision of a qualified manager and a university internship supervisor. All HMT, DHN, & RTM courses must be completed with a "C" or better.
