### **Overview**

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Science at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to a Bachelor of Science in Landscape Architecture.

### **Admission Requirements**

Students must meet the University admission requirements to be admitted into any major within the College of Agriculture Food and Environment (M-G CAFE).

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

### **Degree Requirements**

The College of Agriculture, Food, and Environment requires that students achieve a minimum of a 2.0 to graduate. The Department of Landscape Architecture requires students to achieve a **C** grade or better in major design studios in to advance to the next level. Studio courses are thus taken sequentially.
