



TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE

Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Science in Family Financial Counseling

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Arts at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to the Bachelor of Science in Family Financial Counseling at the University of Kentucky.

Admission Requirements

Students must meet the University admission requirements to be admitted into any major within the Martin-Gatton College of Agriculture, Food, and Environment (MGCAFE).

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

Degree Requirements

The Martin-Gatton College of Agriculture, Food, and Environments requires that students complete an approved academic enrichment, experience, 45 credit hours at the 300-level or higher, and 120 cumulative credit hours.

The Martin Gatton College of Agriculture, Food, and Environment, Family Financial Counseling (FFC)major requires that KCTCS students have taken BAS 120 as well as ECO 201, ECO 202, and ACC 201. The FFC major will require students to take two internships following your May commencement participation with an August graduation date.

General Transfer Requirements
