Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Science in Family
Sciences with a major in Human Development and
Family Science

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Arts at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to a Bachelor of Science in Family Sciences with a major in Human Development and Family Science at the University of Kentucky.

Admission Requirements

Students must meet the University admission requirements to be admitted into any major within the Martin-Gatton College of Agriculture, Food and Environment (MGCAFE).

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

Degree Requirements

The Martin-Gatton College of Agriculture, Food and Environment requires that students take BAS120, HDF 252, HDF 253, as well as COM 252 prior to transferring to UK.

The Human Development and Family Sciences major requires a minor. Examples include Psychology, Sociology, Community and Leadership Development, Kinesiology & Health Promotion, Communication, Criminology, etc.). Your UK advisor will assist you in choosing one. The Family Sciences degree also requires you to complete an internship and 45 hours of upper-level credit.

General Transfer Requirements
